

Wynnedale Town Council Budget Meeting  
October 12, 2016 at the Fitness Farm

All Council members were present plus 10 Wynnedale citizens

The proposed budget for the 2107 year was presented by Jarnell Craig. A number of questions were asked by the attendee about the sources of the Town's revenue streams. The Town's annual income from several tax streams and royalty payments like Comcast is about \$22,000 per year. The Town does not spend all of these funds each year and is thereby able to accumulate funds for bigger projects like street maintenance over a 10+ year time span. The potential costs for street resurfacing in the south part of Town were also presented and discussed. The council is planning to move ahead with street repair in 2107 if financially feasible. After close of the discussion the Town Council voted to accept the proposed budget.

Several other issues were raised by the attendees and Council members. One issue was whether the Town has any ordinances or other jurisdiction over homeowners being able to overnight park their business related vehicles like painting or construction trucks in their driveways. The council will research this issue. Another issue was the continuing discussions with Marion County DPW regarding responsibility for maintenance of the approximate 400 foot section of Cold Spring Road between Wilshire and Wynnedale Roads. A third issue was continuation of the security patrols the Town has hired. The fourth issue was whether to have Town dumpsters once or twice per year.

The Council approved moving ahead with dumpsters for this fall but will revisit the once vs twice per year issue in the spring of 2017.
