

Wynnedale Town Council Meeting
Minutes for March 18, 2015

In attendance: Council members- Judy Hall, John Kincaid, Fritz Hohlt, Janet Gibson, Vimal Mehta and Jarnell Burks-Craig Guest: Steve Coates and Craig Rice

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm on February 11, 2015 by President Judy Hall.

Approval of the Agenda with additions was moved by Judy and second by John. Motion carried.

Minutes of the January 14, 2015 meeting – It was moved by Judy and second by Fritz for minutes to be approved with correction.

Treasurer's Report:

Report was given for January 2015:

Total Business checking balance for January was \$9,565.37

Total Money Market balance for January was \$65,555.30

The treasurer reported that all reports due were completed.

Unfinished Business:

- A. **Street Signs**—only one signs needs to be replaced at the corner of Wilshire and Roland Rd.
- B. Bend poles will be handled by John and Steve.
- C. **Security**—Elite Security owner—Brad Bentley was present –give an overview of services contract for the Town of Wynnedale—Certified Law Enforcement Officers will be available to provide roving patrol security for the Town. The cost of providing security is \$37.50 per hour. The schedule, for security will vary to benefit the needs of the Town. The patrols will be a minimum of 2 hours increments. He instructed us to always call 911..it's very unlikely that a police will be present when a crime is being committed...he is available for individual personal service upon request. The council agreed to continue with the service and revisit again in 6 months. It is the general feeling of the council that the council is not responsible for the security of the town that it rest with the IMPD.

- E. Next Door Wynnedale—will encourage residents of the town to join but the official website for the town - www.Wynnedale.org- where all business of the town will be posted.
