

Wynnedale Town Council Meeting

Minutes for March 13, 2019 presented on April 10, 2019

In attendance: Council members – John Kincaid, Vimal Mehta, Mary Beth Schneider, Judy Hall, Janet Gibson and Jarnell Burks-Craig Guest: Sue Rice

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by the Vimal Mehta the agenda was adopted with additions

Minutes for the February - It was moved by Judy and second by John for the minutes to be approved with correction.

Treasurer's report—Total deposit for March was 1,433.61 balance brought forward \$6,606.61 expenses were \$3,130.04 leaving an ending balance of \$ 4,910.18 in checking.

MM total \$ 75,763.13 as of March 13, 2019 (correct for Feb the year was 2019).

W2 update was given –W2 were put in all council members boxes and the W3 was mailed to the IRS and Social Security with a check.

The council agreed to pay the outstanding bills for CMT (these bills were mailed to another address). CMT would also be contacted regarding the damaged caused by Calumet to the curve at Knollton and Wilshire

Janet was asked to contact the Crime Watch volunteers to share with them the need to start watching and reporting any strange activities in the neighborhood. They should ask the neighbors to first call 911 and then call the captain.

Bids for Lawn Care and Snow removal was discussed –awaiting approval of RFI. We have received two proposal to date.

The council approved the removing of the middle pole at the dead end of Knollton Road. Nothing else will be added at this time.

John is working on the street light on the south part of the esplanade.

Dumpsters were approved for mid -May or June 1, 2019

Website—John Swartzendruber is moving (we will miss him and his family) and will no longer be able to manage our website. The council ask John if he would ask Bruce Ranger if he would volunteer to work with the town council on managing and posting information on the town website.

The members of the council reiterated that the business of the town should flow through the town council and any member of the town is free to offer comments and/or suggestions on any issues or concerns.
