

Wynnedale Town Council Meeting

Minutes for May 8, 2019 presented on June 12, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by the Vimal Mehta the agenda was adopted with additions

Minutes for the April - It was moved by Judy and second by Janet for the minutes to be approved with correction.

Treasurer's report—Total deposit for May was \$2,074 plus balance brought forward \$2,019.95 expenses were \$2,379.54 leaving an ending balance of \$ 1,714.41 in checking.

The council continues to pay the outstanding bills for CMT. Calumet will be call to repair the curb. **The curb was repaired but much debris was left that the neighbors had to clean up.**

Bids for Lawn Care and Snow removal was discussed would be email to the council for vote—the voting will be by email. **The lawn care bid was awarded to JD Lawn Care in the amount of \$4,610. Janet Gibson will notify Mr. Darring, he will be expected to start as soon as possible.**

The council approved the removing of the middle pole at the dead end of Knollton Road. The Clerk/Treasurer will check with Joshua to see when the job will be completed. **The pole at the dead end of Knollton is removed and Mr. Darring has been paid.**

Dumpsters will be in the town June 1, 2019. **John will arrange for the dumpsters to be in place on this day.**

Bruce Ranger agreed to manage the town website. He will be volunteering his services. The town council will work with him on managing and posting information on the town website. Bruce has received all minutes for 2019. **Minutes for the council meeting will be sent to Bruce as soon as possible after approval.**

The council agreed to send welcome letter and the town directory to all new residents. We currently have 97 families in Wynnedale.

The ditch at Knollton and Paula Lane was clean out by John Kincaid it is in the need of a beehive, Sue Rice will purchase and be reimbursed.
